Day 1 Tuesday, June 28, 2016

Board your overnight flight to Zurich!

Day 2

Wednesday, June 29, 2016

Arrive in Zurich and transfer to the Lucerne Region

Recall the legends of folk hero William Tell (and his fortunate aim) as you overnight in the Vierwaldstättersee (Lake Lucerne) region.

Walking Tour of Lucerne (time permitting)

The majestic Alps provide a stunning backdrop to your tour of Lucerne, where composer Richard Wagner wrote several of his major works. You'll view the Löwendenkmal (Lion Monument), a sandstone statue commemorating the Swiss Guards slain in the 1792 Paris storming of the Tuileries. According to Mark Twain, it is "the saddest and most compassionate piece of rock on earth." Stroll down narrow, winding streets and across the Kapellbrücke, a covered bridge whose history dates back to medieval days-the murals lining its walls are nearly identical to those painted in the 14th century.

Day 3

Thursday, June 30, 2016

Excursion to Interlaken

Transfer today to the "town between the lakes." Interlaken has been a vacation resort for over three hundred years, as it offers stunning views of the mountains, as well as a history of visitors including Mark Twain.

Whitewater Rafting Excursion

Feel the water splash and hear the roar of the river as you enjoy a rafting excursion along Interlaken. The beautiful scenery passes by as adrenaline pumps through your body on this spine-tingling adventure!

Overnight in Lucerne

Excursion to Liechtenstein & Wasserauen

Walking tour of Vaduz

Journey to Liechtenstein, an alpine principality which dates back to the Holy Roman Empire. Today the country is one of the world's largest producers of false-teeth! Have a taste of the local flavor during your stop here, with some free time to explore the area on your own, before passing the royal family's hilltop castle as you continue through the mountains.

Hike up to Ascher Cliffside Restaurant

This truly unique restaurant can only be reached either by cable car or a 3-hour hike up the mountain. Once you arrive at the summit, take in the sweeping views of the Swiss Alps. Enjoy dinner with your group before you head back down via cable car.

Saturday, July 2, 2016

Excursion to Interlaken

Guided Hike of the Eiger Trail up to Grindelwald

Join your guide today as you take on this challenging hike through the heart of the Swiss Alps. Please be sure to wear appropriate hiking gear including shoes, hat and sunscreen.

Ropes Adventure Park

Head into the forest where you will find an adventure park with wooden bridges, tarzan swings and zip lines 20 meters above-ground! You will be equipped with everything you need when you arrive on-site, but be sure to wear your hiking boots.

Sunday, July 3, 2016

Take the Gondola up Mt. Rigi to your Hotel

Free Time to Explore Mt. Rigi

There's plenty to do on top of this majestic mountain. You might want to follow one of the many trails on a morning hike, or perhaps you'd like to try your hand at cheese-making! Your hotel also comes equipped with a wellness center and spa, so be sure to take advantage of all that it has to offer.
